  - ▶ **ReThink Disposable**<sup>™</sup> Focus on eliminating the use of plastics, foam and "single-use disposables" (SUDs) at its greatest source — restaurants, food trucks, and institutions. This is an effective voluntary program proven to save small businesses thousands of dollars every year, as well as actively engage the public and businesses in the larger "Reuse Revolution". The World Economic Forum predicts that there will be more plastics (by weight) in the ocean than fish by 2050.
    - ► **Climate Change** Secure state policies designed to achieve 100% green economy strategies by 2050. Create wide range of family-supporting jobs. Ensure climate justice in disproportionately

impacted communities of color and low income. As a result, the Garden State will be more economically sustainable and ecologically resilient to future climate impacts.
